TOPIC'S OF DISCUSSION:

- Treasurer's Report – Bank balance as of 10/20/08 \$10,546.27 {Pending Bal: \$10,868.62 [11/7/08] Profit/Expense was issued for the following:
  - FB Programs            Income: \$4,508.00/Expense \$1,949.50 Profit: \$2,558.50
  - Concessions            Income: \$7,245.00/Expense \$2,575.44 Profit: \$4,669.56
  - Spirit Wear/Candy    Income: \$6,931.50/Expense \$4,873.00 Profit: \$2,058.50
  - Grand Total in Profit for all three: \$9,286.56!!!
- Guest Speakers:
  - Anne Gellrich – Ms. Gellrich spoke about a self study into RSHS becoming an “accredited school”. There is a survey on the school website for parents to fill out so that she may have valuable input from the community. Everyone is encouraged to look it up and fill it out.   - Doris & Chip Bixler: [cdbixler@comcast.net] Mr. And Mrs. Bixler came to speak to us about how to manage a 5K run. We need to decide where we would like to hold the run, would the sheriff's department be needed depending on where the run would take place, food, gifts, and numbers for the runners and volunteers will be needed for this event. Their cost for doing the race would be \$250. Their responsibility would be to map out the course, time it, and do the ceremony in the end. We would need to advertise at least two months in advance. We can check out several websites to get ideas and info such as: races2run.com We will need someone to chair this event. It would be open to everyone. It would benefit the athletes of RSHS. Some of the member will try to get some feedback from local runners on how/if we should go ahead with this event. We will take a vote the next meeting as to whether we will do this or not. Looking to hold the event in March although the 15<sup>th</sup> and last weekend in March is unavailable.
